As of this report, questions have surfaced regarding the awarding of scholarships from the preceding year. This is most likely attributed to the recent mailing of the 2010 scholarship package to all detachments of Pennsylvania, during the past fall season. Any verifications of full-time enrollment (which have since been received by me) have been remitted to the attention of the prior scholarship chairman, who has since informed me that these documents have satisfied the requirements of the application process and the relevant awards will be issued.

There was also a recent inquiry concerning whether an applicant could have multiple sponsors. The scholarship committee was consulted and everyone unanimously agreed that there should be only one (1) sponsor and only one (1) application per each applicant.

Please note that applications need not be requested directly from the scholarship chairman via mail. Those forms already mailed to each detachment can be photocopied or others can be printed from the Department web site. There is also no requirement that the completed and submitted document be in color, as it appears on the web site. The aforesaid approved scholarship package is the only acceptable application format for 2010 and any older version of the application will be rejected, but a subsequent application on the proper form will be accepted (if received by the deadline).

Mention should be made of the Lehigh Valley Detachment for a generous donation of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) towards the Department Scholarship Program. This contribution is highly appreciated and will assist the college award recipients of 2010. Please note that donation forms are also available to commemorate one's honor or memory.

My goal of fulfilling the responsibilities of this program while providing appreciable satisfaction to our membership will be easily attained with the continued cooperation of our membership.
