Marine Corps League Department Scholarships of \$250.00 were awarded to 92 students in 2010. The deadline for candidates to complete requirements in order to receive this award was 31 December, by which date 12 scholarships were not issued. Reasons for disqualification were a result of candidates either not responding with verification of full-time enrollment in an institution of higher learning or finding that they were only attending on a part-time basis.

The list of candidates was posted on the Marine Corps League Department Website after the 2010 Department Convention. Congratulatory letters were mailed to each candidate in September of that year, with the explanation that he or she was yet required to return correspondence to include verification of attendance and an address to which the award should be sent. An e-mail reminder was sent to the remaining candidates, who had not yet responded to that letter, in early December.

As of this date, all unclaimed scholarship monies have reverted to the scholarship fund for the next year. Minor revisions in both the instructions and the application of 2011 are presently pending approval by the committee and board, after which they will be posted on the Department Website. Applications will not be accepted until February of 2011, however.

Several scholarship award recipients have returned words of gratitude. Although too numerous to print here; I echo their words by thanking all those, who assisted in this process.

Donations to the scholarship program have been appreciably received. A form to accompany such donations – in memory or honor of another – is available on the Department Website.

It has been my privilege to serve our Marine Corps League in this capacity. With continued efforts to provide an appreciable and satisfying scholarship program to our members and students, I remain.
